### **KITCHEN SCRAPS**



Fruit & Vegetable matter, Egg shells, Coffee grounds, Tea bags

Cut up scraps in to small pieces. Sprinkle baking soda on scraps to minimize odour or freeze scraps until dropoff if possible.

NO meat, bones, dairy, fats or oils.



# YARD WASTE

Grass, Leaves, Trees, Shrubs, Branches & Limbs (up to 4" diameter)


Please debag all material.

## **PLASTICS**



#### **PETE - Polyethylene Terephthalate**

Commonly used for: soft drink and water bottles, salad trays, salad dressing and peanut butter containers, medicine jars, biscuit trays, egg trays





### **HDPE - High Density Polyethylene**

Commonly used for: *milk bottles, ice cream* containers, juice bottles, shampoo and conditioner bottles. soap bottles. deteraents







#### PP - Polypropylene

Commonly used for: bottle caps, food containers, drinking straws, ice cream tubs, margarine tubs, microwave meal trays, prescription bottles



**NO** Motor Oil Bottles, Plastic Bags or Film, Plastics other than #1 #2 #5

Please rinse all plastics and remove lids or caps. Remove labels and flatten container if possible.

## **CARDBOARD**

#### **Corrugated Cardboard & Pizza boxes**

Please remove any packing materials and flatten boxes. NO laminated, waxed, printed or otherwise coated boxes or cartons





#### **Aluminum Beverage Cans**

Rinsed soda, juice and beer cans. Do not crush.

NO tin cans (food, aerosol, paint, fuel)

DO NOT CRUSH
